NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 11:30 a.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the July 20, 2023, Board meeting;
3. Receive the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2023 tax rate and authorize:
 - A. the required notice that the Board will consider adoption of a tax rate; and
 - B. the means of providing such notice;
4. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
5. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented, approval of tax refunds, and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
6. Report any legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney; take any action in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
7. Engineer's report, including:
 - A. Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District, and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295 ("TEC Form 1295");
 - B. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable; and
 - C. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable; and the taking of any action in connection therewith;
8. Operator's Report, including:
 - A. Levels of chlorine residuals;
 - B. Authorize repair and maintenance of District facilities, and authorize acceptance of TEC form 1295, as applicable;
 - C. Appeal(s) of District charges;

- D. Refer accounts for collection;
 - E. Approve write-off of uncollectible accounts; and
 - F. Water accountability;
 - G. Status of implementation of the District's Drought Contingency Plan; and
 - H. Discussion regarding the District's Rate Order, as necessary;
- 9. Developer's Report;
 - 10. Closed session for consultation with attorney regarding pending and/or threatened litigation;
 - 11. Reconvene in open session and authorize action on matters discussed in closed session;
 - 12. Attorney's Report;
 - 13. Consider matters for possible placement on future agendas.
