NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

**The meeting will be held on Monday, April 10, 2023, at 11:00 a.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Receive public comments, including comments and requests submitted through the District's website, and matters of public interest;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Directors held on March 27, 2023;
3. Discussion regarding payroll processing services for Director per diems, expense reimbursements, and related tax payments and reporting, including approval of Client Services Agreement with HR&P, Inc. and acknowledgment of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295 ("TEC Form 1295") in connection with same;
4. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing Electronic Transfer of Funds for Director Per Diems and Expense Reimbursements;
5. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports and the payment of invoices presented;
6. Consider review and approval of draft operating budgets for Fiscal Year ending May 31, 2023, prepared by Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 418 (the "Master District") pursuant to that certain Contract for Financing, Operation and Maintenance of Master Water and Sanitary Sewer Facilities (the "Master Facilities Contract") by and between the District and the Master District;
7. Receive Tax Assessor-Collector report and approve payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
8. Adopt Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes and authorize the delinquent tax attorney to pursue the collection of delinquent real property taxes beginning July 1, 2023, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
9. Report on legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, authorize foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
10. Operator's Report, including:
  - a) Monthly report;
  - b) Status of compliance with permits;

- c) Repair and maintenance of District facilities;
  - d) Appeals of District charges and consideration of customer comments;
  - e) Status of investigation regarding water quality;
  - f) Status of installation of smart meters and status of communication with residents regarding same;
  - g) Water Smart Partners Program discussion and authorize action in connection therewith, including status of participation in community programs;
  - h) Status of high water usage program and issuance of notices regarding same;
  - i) Discuss status of Televising and Air Scouring Program;
  - j) Discuss potential fuel alternatives for District facilities;
  - k) Review valve survey and authorize action in connection therewith;
  - l) Discuss incentive program for residents to participate in water smart measures;
  - m) Authorize operator to prepare draft Consumer Confidence Report for review by Board of Directors; and
  - n) Review of annual API rate increases;
11. Engineer's Report, including:
- a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District;
  - b) Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District;
  - c) Status of construction of water, sewer and drainage facilities and paving to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders, and acceptance by Harris County of streets for maintenance;
  - d) Authorizing the design, advertisement, or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of contracts for the construction of recreational facilities within the District;
  - e) Status of construction of recreational facilities to serve land within the District, and the approval of any change orders;
  - f) Discussion regarding status of general landscaping improvements within the District, including review of proposals for maintenance of District facilities;
  - g) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and conveyance of sites and/or facilities by the District, including:
    - i. Conveyance of Facilities - Bridgeland Creek Parkway Utility Extension;
  - h) Status of storm water permitting related to construction within the District, and the taking of action in connection therewith;
  - i) Status of acceptance by Harris County of streets and storm sewers for maintenance; and
  - j) Discussion regarding Capital Improvements Plan, and authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;

Consider projects available for funding with surplus bond proceeds and, if necessary, adoption of an Order Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Approval of Projects and the Use of Surplus Construction Funds and Interest Earned on Construction Funds in connection therewith;
13. Garbage Collection and Recycling Report from Republic Services, Inc.;

14. Status of law enforcement services within the District; discuss status of safety committee and coordination with Harris County Constable, Precinct 5 and Bridgeland Council, Inc. regarding patrols within Bridgeland; discuss coordination with Bridgeland Council, Inc. on other matters; status of installation of trial Flock license readers;
15. Status of committee discussions regarding resident communications and emergencies; status of implementation of Emergency Communications Committee Charter;
16. Discuss status of creation of administrative agency to serve special districts serving the Bridgeland community, and execution of Interlocal Agreement creating said agency;
17. Updates and revisions to District website;
18. Developer's report;
19. Authorize engagement of Arbitrage Compliance Specialists, Inc. to prepare a Final Report for the District's \$3,570,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2012, and acknowledgement of TEC Form 1295 for same;

21. Schedule of future Board meetings; and
22. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
