NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 16720 Pine Forest Lane, Houston, Harris County, Texas, 77084, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 10, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Comments from the public;
2. Approval of minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on September 12, 2023;
3. Conduct public hearing regarding adoption of the District's proposed 2023 tax rate;
4. Levy of the District's 2023 maintenance tax rate, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
5. Amendment to the Third Amended and Restated District Information Form relative to the District's 2023 tax rate;
6. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment Reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
7. Status of compliance by the District with Texas Government Code, Chapter 2265, relative to energy reporting and authorize any action in connection therewith;
8. Annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution and amended Order in connection therewith;
9. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented; approve of tax refunds and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;

 2. Rebuild or retrofit Waste Water Treatment Plant ("WWTP") conveyor;
 - (ii) Replacement of weirs at WWTP;
 - b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation, maintenance purposes and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, including:
 - (i) Air Repair Project No. 2; and
 - c) Review and approval of Capital Improvement Plan;
