MINUTES CINCO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 3

June 15, 2023

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC AND FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

There were no public comments.

APPROVE MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of the May 18, 2023, regular meeting. After review and discussion, Director Schroeder moved that the minutes be approved, as submitted. Director Och seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DISCUSS SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON MASON ROAD

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING MATTERS

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Riley presented and reviewed the bookkeeper's report and payment of the bills, a copy of which is attached. After review and discussion, Director Schroeder moved to approve the bookkeeper's report and payment of the bills. Director Fahey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

TAX ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTIONS MATTERS; INCLUDING DELINQUENT TAX COLLECTIONS AND PAYMENT OF TAX BILLS

Ms. Highberger presented and reviewed the tax assessor/collector's report, delinquent tax roll and uncollectible personal property accounts with the Board, copies of which are attached. After review and discussion, Director Fahey moved to approve the tax assessor/collector's report including payment of the tax bills and writing off uncollectible personal property accounts. Director Och seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

AUTHORIZE DELINQUENT TAX ATTORNEY TO PROCEED WITH COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES

Mr. Vaughan stated the Board may authorize the delinquent tax attorney to begin collection of the District's 2022 delinquent taxes as of July 1, 2023. Following review and discussion, Director Och moved to authorize the delinquent tax attorney to begin collection of the 2022 delinquent taxes as of July 1, 2023. Director Schroeder seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

OPERATION OF DISTRICT FACILITIES/TERMINATION OF SERVICE

Mr. Miller presented and reviewed the operator's report, a copy of which is attached. He discussed operation, maintenance, and repairs of District facilities. He stated that the water accountability for the previous month was 93%.

Mr. Miller reviewed the North Fort Bend Water Authority 2023 Water Conservation Program initiatives.

Mr. Miller presented a list of delinquent customers and reported the residents on the termination list were delinquent in payment of their water and sewer bills and were given written notification, in accordance with the District's Rate Order, prior to the meeting of the opportunity to appear before the Board of Directors to explain, contest, or correct their bills and to show why utility services should not be terminated for reason of non-payment.

After review and discussion, Director Schroeder moved to (1) approve the operator's report; (2) authorize termination of delinquent accounts in accordance with the District's Rate Order; and (3) direct that the delinquent customer list be filed

appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Fahey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
