

NOTICE OF MEETING
CINCO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 12

The Board of Directors of Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 12 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, July 11, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the Cinco Ranch Residential Property Association, 3022 Windemere Park Lane, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

2. Comments from the public.
3. Approve minutes.

5. Update on Central Green events.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, writing off uncollectible personal property accounts, and report regarding sales tax revenues, if appropriate.
7. Authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
8. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and amendment of budget, if appropriate.
9. Discuss Association of Water Board Directors summer conference, approve reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at winter conference.
10. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. Phase II MS4 permitting matters;
 - b. requests for consents to encroachment, utility commitment letters or reservations of capacity from Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1; and
 - c. pedestrian signs and traffic light coordination near Cinco Ranch High School.
11. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs and maintenance, and water bill messages;
 - b. update on fire hydrant repairs;
 - c. amend Rate Order, if appropriate; and
 - d. Water Conservation Provider Program.
12. Termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
13. Update on LMA Landscape improvements, including:
 - a. landscape damages due to freeze event and proposal for replacement;
 - b. park enhancements, including tree plantings and walking trail; and
 - c. tree removal and vegetation replacement throughout the District.

14. Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1 status of the desalination plant.
15. Discuss security reports and authorize appropriate action.
16. Update on Flock security camera installation and discuss LaCenterra and Central Green security.
17. Community improvements, including Willow Fork Drainage District bike access project donation.
18. Noise walls and authorize appropriate action.
19. Corps of Engineer's upstream litigation.
20. Meeting schedule, including scheduling special meeting, if appropriate, and items for inclusion on the next agenda.
